- A multidisciplinary treatment team that provides a structured, supportive environment with a focus on safety to facilitate stabilization and step-down to lower levels of care
- A wide range of therapies, including individual therapy; milieu therapy; art therapy; and process-oriented, experiential, and psychoeducational group therapies
- Collaboration with each patient's outpatient treatment team to ensure a smooth transition upon discharge
- Educational focus; post-doctoral fellowships in psychology and psychiatry are available
