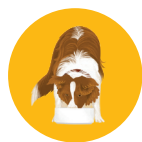

Entyce is a prescription treatment specifically designed to increase appetite in dogs.

Entyce is safe to use daily, and can be used long-term.*

In clinical studies after only 4 days of treatment, nearly 7 out of 10 dogs had improved appetite.^{†4}

HOW DOES ENTYCE WORK?



Entyce works by mimicking your dog's natural 'hunger hormone' – a hormone called ghrelin. This hormone causes dogs to feel hungry, which helps improve appetite.

*The ability of Entyce to increase appetite long-term is unknown. Your veterinarian can determine if your dog is benefiting long-term and prescribe Entyce accordingly.

†Compared to less than 5/10 control dogs.

The most common side effects are diarrhea, vomiting, elevated blood urea nitrogen, increased thirst, and excessive saliva production.

CONVENIENT, ONCE-DAILY DOSING

Entyce is a flavored solution that is administered into your dog's mouth once daily.



DOSING INSTRUCTIONS – 2 EASY STEPS



1. Gently shake the bottle and then insert the syringe. Draw out the amount of liquid prescribed by your veterinarian

2. Insert the syringe into your dog's mouth and press the plunger to dispense the entire dose. Rinse the syringe with water when you are finished

What is Entyce?

- Entyce is a prescription medication that can help stimulate your dog's appetite.
- Entyce mimics the action of ghrelin (the hunger hormone) to trigger feelings of hunger.

What dogs should NOT take Entyce?

- Dogs that have had an allergic reaction to Entyce (capromorelin)

What is the most important information I should know about Entyce?

- **Not for use in humans. Keep this and all medications out of reach of children and pets. For oral use in dogs only. In case of accidental ingestion by humans, consult a physician and call 1-888-545-5973.**
- **Use Entyce with caution in:** dogs with liver or kidney problems.
- **Entyce has not been tested in:** dogs that are pregnant, lactating, or intended for breeding.

What are the possible side effects of Entyce?

The most common side effects include:

- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Elevated blood urea nitrogen
- Increased thirst
- Hypersalivation

Contact your veterinarian if your dog experiences these, or any other conditions.
