RESEARCH

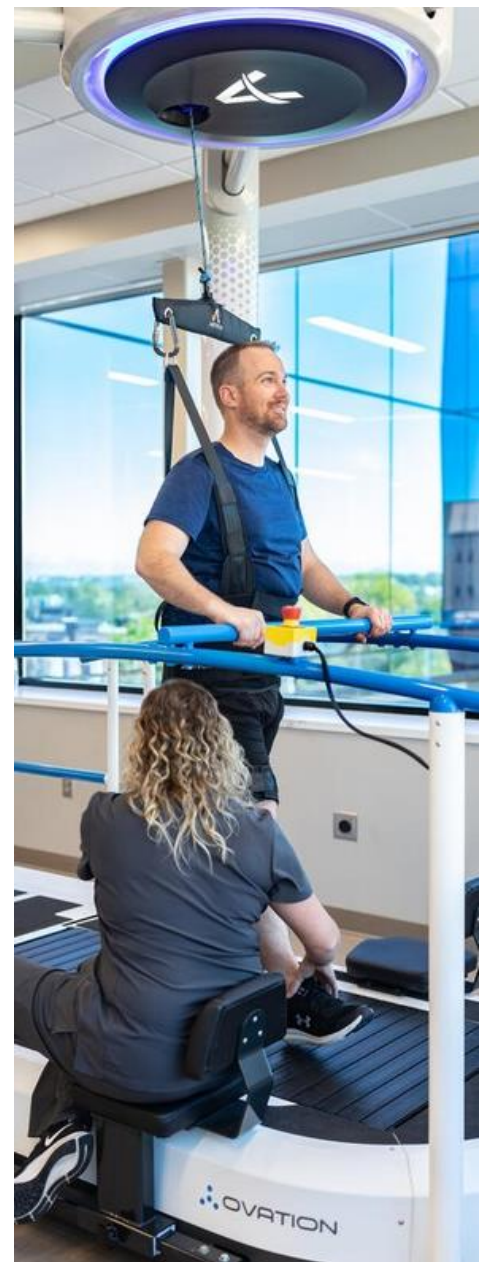
- Mentorship and dedicated time to pursue research are provided
