How can I request open access?

You must select open access during the initial submission process and complete the required questions.

What is Peds Open Choice?

It is your choice whether to publish in the open access journal, *Pediatrics Open Science*, or in the traditional hybrid subscription flagship journal, *Pediatrics*.

Pediatrics Open Science is a platform for authors who need to comply with funder open access mandates or want to broaden the dissemination of their research through our global open access program. Select your journal of choice.

Pediatrics Open Science (Open Access Journal)

Pediatrics Open Science is an entirely open access journal with no paywalls or gated content. Articles are immediately free to read upon publication. The journal offers additional promotional efforts with your paid open access fee. This journal also helps authors meet funder / institution open access mandates. Authors may choose to publish in Pediatrics Open Science regardless of whether they have a funder open access mandate. Authors may choose between one of two Creative Commons licenses (CC-BY or CC-BY-NC-ND).

Pediatrics® (Hybrid Subscription Journal)

Pediatrics is a subscription journal that offers a premium open access option. Open access articles are only published under a CC-BY-NC-ND license. Authors may request to have their article transferred to the open access journal if not accepted in *Pediatrics*. In addition to the open access option, *Pediatrics* continues to publish non-open access content.

What is the open access fee?

Pediatrics Open Science -

APC: \$3,100 (CC-BY-NC-ND license); \$4,500 (CC-BY license)

Pediatrics® - APC: \$3,900 (CC-BY-NC-ND license)

A 15% discount for AAP Members is available.

You must pay open access fees upon acceptance of your paper, prior to publication. Fees cover the costs of production, monthly hosting, marketing, archiving, and downstream deposits to repositories. It is the authors' responsibility to obtain payment from their funding organizations or institutions. All decisions to accept manuscripts are based solely on editorial criteria. You can pay by credit card. If a different payment model is requested, please contact the editorial office.

How do I make my article open access?

- Determine which journal you want to publish your article in.
- Submit your paper to the journal of your choice by clicking on "Submit Your Manuscript" located on the online journal site.
- Your manuscript will be reviewed by editors.
- · Upon acceptance, pay the open access fee.

Fees are not charged until your paper is accepted. There is no fee to submit an article for consideration of publication. Note: Selecting open access does not guarantee acceptance. All decisions to accept manuscripts are based solely on editorial criteria.

Will my article be compliant with open access funder mandates?



Pediatrics Open Science is compliant with open access policies from major funders, including Gates Foundation, Wellcome Trust, Research Councils UK, US National Institutes of Health, etc.

*Note: Pediatrics may not meet funder mandates. Please verify your funder requirements for open access publishing.

How will my article be indexed if published in *Pediatrics Open Science*?

Articles published in *Pediatrics Open Science* will be immediately indexed in Google Scholar and CrossRef. To index the open access journal as it becomes eligible, the editorial team will work with major indexers such as PubMed Central, Web of Science, Scopus, and the Directory of Open Access Journals.

What if my article is not accepted for publication by *Pediatrics*®?



You may indicate at submission to have your article transferred to Pediatrics Open Science for consideration.



What is my publication date?

If your article is accepted for publication, you will be notified via email of the date of publication.
