

Starting ABA Services

1. Get a Diagnosis & Referral

- A recent diagnostic report indicating that your child has Autism Spectrum Disorder
- A prescription or referral from your child's physician

2. Submit Paperwork to Insurance

We will request information about your insurance, financials, as well as your family's availability, etc. that insurance companies require to assess whether services will be covered.

3. Behavior Assessment (FBA Process)

A functional behavior assessment (FBA) will be completed by a Board-Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) following approval by your insurance company.

4. Receive Prescription (Therapy Hours)

Recommendations include hours that your child will receive direct 1:1 hours, supervision hours, and parent education hours.

5. Circle Back with Insurance Company

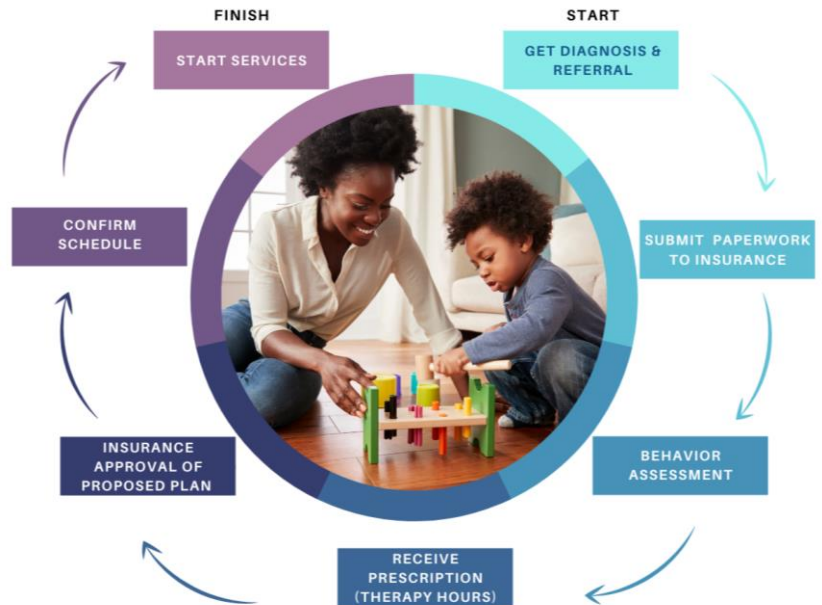
There is typically a 15-business day timeline where we wait for approval from your insurance company. Each insurance company has a different timeline.

6. It's Scheduling Time!

The scheduling department will contact you and propose a schedule to fulfill the recommended hours (prescription) and confirm a start date for services.

7. Start Services
