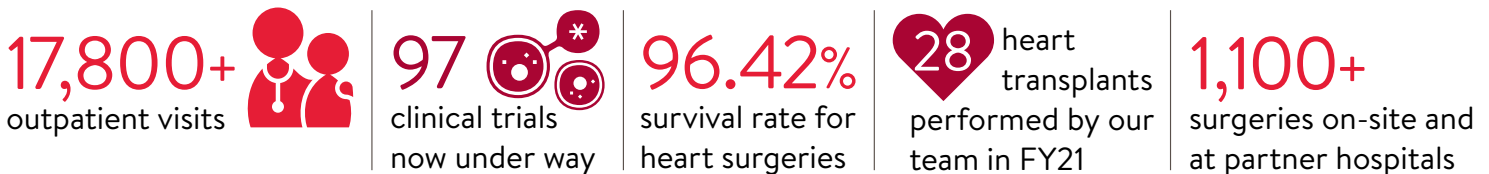
Heart Center highlights

- Outperforming many of our peer hospitals, having remarkable outcomes, despite tackling some of the most complex cardiac issues in children.
