Tests and Treatments

Your patients will have access to the latest technology and techniques in orthopedics at Gillette.

Some of the available orthopedic procedures for children, teens and adults include:

- Gait and motion analysis
- Limb-length surgery
- Ponseti method for clubfoot
- Radiology and imaging tests including EOSedge X-ray imaging (low-dose radiation)
- Single-event multilevel surgery (SEMLS) and various individual orthopedic surgery procedures
- Spine Fusion
- Magnetically driven growing rods to treat spine conditions
- Vertical expandable prosthetic titanium rib (VEPTR) surgery
- Vertebral body tethering (VBT) surgery
- Nonsurgical interventions to treat spine conditions, including Schroth therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy bracing and night bracing

Prenatal Consultations

If your patient has a condition that can be diagnosed prenatally, such as amniotic band syndrome, clubfoot, or limb or spine deformities, the family might meet with an orthopedist for a prenatal consultation. The consultation provides education, treatment options and counseling.

Specialized Care

The Gillette orthopedics team is composed of experts who've chosen to specialize in the unique needs of children, teens and adults who have highly complex conditions. At Gillette, your patients will benefit from expertise gained in 125 years of providing orthopedic care.

Acute Orthopedic Treatment

At the Gillette Acute Orthopedic Clinic, patients are evaluated and treated for complex injuries and infections of bones or muscle. There they can take advantage of same-day appointments and 24-hour provider consultations—which give primary and urgent/emergency care providers access to our specialists.

The Gillette Acute Orthopedic Clinic is staffed by pediatric orthopedic specialists. Patients visit a highly trained pediatric orthopedist (without the need for an emergency room visit).

Craniofacial and Plastic Surgery

At Gillette Children's, your patients will have access to leading craniofacial surgeons and other providers who specialize in caring for kids who have complex conditions. Whether treatment begins in infancy or early childhood, our goal is to improve your patients' function and physical appearance and promote self-confidence.

Conditions Our Craniofacial and Plastic Surgery Team Treats

A wide variety of conditions affect the face and skull. Our specialists perform plastic surgery for congenital abnormalities, traumatic injuries, hand deformities, complex wounds and other conditions that affect appearance and abilities.

Some of the conditions we treat most often include:

- Deformational plagiocephaly
- Torticollis
- Craniosynostosis
- Cleft lip and palate
- Craniofacial anomalies associated with congenital syndrome/s
- Facial injuries and trauma
- Hand deformities
- Hemangiomas

Tests and Treatments

Your patients will have access to the latest technology and techniques in reconstructive surgery at Gillette.

Consultations

- Adoption consultations. We consult with families who have adopted or are adopting a child who has an existing craniofacial condition that might not have been successfully treated.
- Prenatal consultations. Because some conditions we treat are diagnosed during pregnancy, we consult with the parents about conditions such as craniosynostosis, craniofacial anomalies and hemangiomas, and cleft lip and palate. We'll also share information about current treatment options, provide appropriate counseling and help plan a course of treatment.

Tests and Evaluations

- Evaluations for craniofacial anomalies associated with congenital syndromes such as 22q11.2 deletion, Apert, Pfeiffer or Treacher-Collins
- Nasendoscopy and other diagnostic testing unique to craniofacial disorders
- Breastfeeding and feeding evaluations for cleft lip and palate
- Audiology, including auditory brainstem response (your patient might be sedated for some tests)

Rehabilitation Medicine

At Gillette Children's, your patients will have access to the highest concentration of pediatric rehabilitation medicine specialists in the nation. Gillette is one of less than 10 U.S. pediatric inpatient rehabilitation facilities to have Commission on the Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) accreditation for both its pediatric specialty and pediatric brain injury programs.

Conditions Our Rehabilitation Medicine Team Treats

Working closely with other specialty areas such as neurology, neurosurgery and orthopedics, our providers treat conditions such as cerebral palsy and related conditions, neuromuscular disorders, as well as many other conditions that affect your patient's development. They oversee rehabilitation care when children experience loss of function secondary to brain and spinal trauma, illness or stroke.

Some of the conditions we treat most often include:

- Cerebral palsy
- Brain injury and related neurotrauma, including concussion and stroke
- Spinal cord injury and related neurotrauma
- Complex movement disorders.
- Dystonia
- Muscular dystrophy and other neuromuscular conditions

For Diagnosing a Condition

The first step in an integrated treatment plan is an accurate diagnosis. Gillette offers these evaluations to help diagnose a condition:

- Evaluation for traumatic and acquired injuries to the brain or spinal cord
- Spasticity evaluations for cerebral palsy and associated conditions
- ImpACT testing for children and adolescents for concussion and related neurotrauma
- Gait and motion analysis for walking and movement disorders
- Assessment of complex movement disorders
- Infant and Toddler Development Evaluation for children ages 0-3

For Medical Management of a Complex Condition

If your patient has cerebral palsy, spasticity or other complex movement disorders, Gillette specialists might recommend evaluations and treatments like:

- Injecting botulinum toxin or phenol, which are spasticity medications
- Implanting and managing an intrathecal baclofen pump, which stores and delivers targeted amounts of medication into the intrathecal space of the spine

Gillette Children's is a regional leader in pediatric neurosurgery. Partnering with Regions Hospital, we were Minnesota's first Level I Pediatric Trauma Center. Certified by the American College of Surgeons, this advanced facility offers the highest level of care for children and teens who have experienced traumatic injuries.

Conditions Our Neurosurgery Team Treats

We treat complex neurological conditions affecting the spinal cord, neck, nerves, and/or brain. We also provide neurosurgical care to treat the secondary effects of complex conditions.

Some of the conditions we treat most often include:

- Cerebral palsy
- Epilepsy and seizures
- Brain injury and related neurotrauma
- Hydrocephalus
- Craniosynostosis
- Spina bifida
- Arachnoid cysts

Tests and Treatments

Your patients will benefit from the latest technology and techniques in neurosurgery at Gillette. Some of our neurosurgery tests and treatments include:

- 3T MRI to detect subtle brain lesions or bleeds that a traditional MRI might not pinpoint
- Cranial vault remodeling for craniosynostosis
- Deep brain stimulation for complex movement disorders
- Intrathecal baclofen pump implantation to manage spasticity
- Selective dorsal rhizotomy surgery for spasticity
- Ventral dorsal rhizotomy surgery for spasticity
- Shunt surgery for hydrocephalus
- Tethered spinal cord release
- Vagus nerve stimulation for epilepsy and seizures

Prenatal Consultations

Because some of the conditions we treat are diagnosed during pregnancy, our neurosurgeons also offer prenatal consultations and diagnosis. We can meet with families and teach them about conditions such as hydrocephalus, spina bifida, neural tube defects and cysts. We also provide education on treatment options and, if appropriate, help plan a course of treatment.

Neurology

At Gillette Children's, our neurologists are experts at diagnosing and treating patients who have complex neurological conditions, including epilepsy. We are accredited by the National Association of Epilepsy Centers (NAEC) as a Level 3 Epilepsy Center.

Conditions Our Neurology Team Treats

Our Neurology department cares for children, teens and adults who have complex neurological conditions, epilepsy and injuries that affect the spinal cord, neck, nerves and/or brain.

Some of the conditions that most often require neurological care include:

- Epilepsy and seizures
- Cerebral palsy
- Brain injury and related neurotrauma, including concussions
- Muscular dystrophy, spinal muscular atrophy and other neuromuscular conditions
- Arteriovenous malformations and other cerebral vascular conditions
- Complex movement disorders
- Microcephaly and other conditions related to atypical brain formation
- Neurocutaneous syndromes
- Neurodevelopmental delays
- Neuroimmunological conditions such as multiple sclerosis and other related disorders, acute demyelinating encephalomyelitis (ADEM), transverse myelitis, optic neuritis and neuromyelitis optica (NMO)
- Autoimmune disorders of the brain, spine and peripheral nerves
- Pediatric stroke and related disorders
- Sleep disorders
- NMDA receptor encephalitis, neuroimmunology leuko-dystrophies, and other metabolic and genetic neurological disorders

Tests and Treatments

Early care is critically important in cases of neurological and neurodevelopmental delays. That's why we offer:

- Deep brain stimulation
- Developmental tests
- Epilepsy life stages visits
- First seizure evaluations
- Genetic evaluation and counseling
- Infant and Toddler Development Evaluation for children ages 0-3
- Intraoperative monitoring
- Ketogenic diet and low glycemic index diet for epilepsy and seizures
- Medical management of epilepsy and seizures
- Neurodiagnostic, including electroencephalography (EEG), video EEG, electromyography and sleep study (polysomnography)
- Neurological care for cerebral palsy and other complex disorders
- Neuropsychology
- Vagus nerve stimulation for epilepsy and seizures
