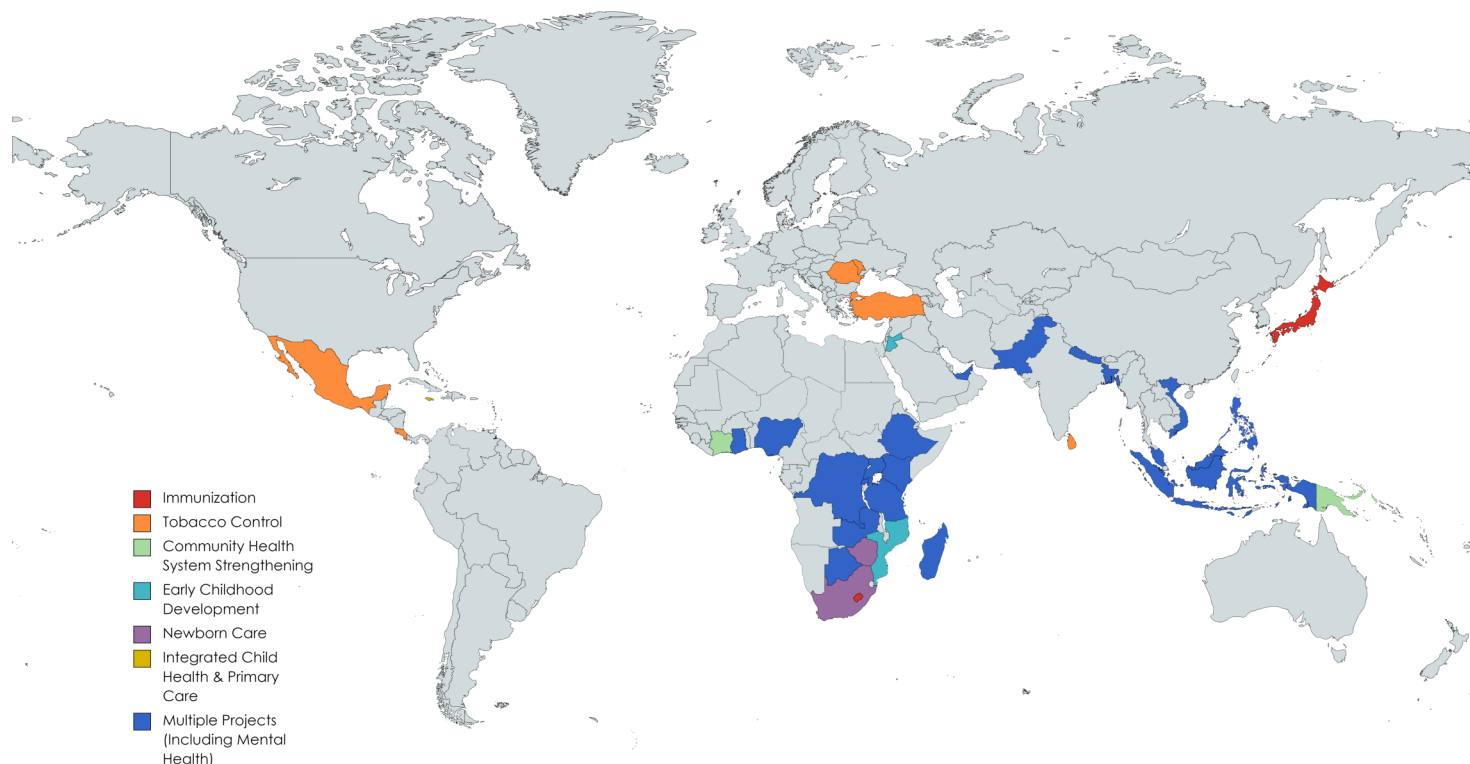

AAP PROGRAMS HAVE A GLOBAL REACH

Newborn Health

- **Neonatal Resuscitation Program** implemented in 143 countries
- **Helping Babies Survive** implemented in 80+ countries with over 1,000,000 birth attendants trained
- **Essential Newborn Care Now! (ENC Now!)** digital solution for remote training currently being piloted in 6 countries
- **Customized mentoRship & Implementation Support Package (CRISP)** to currently being piloted in 2 countries
- **The Immediate Kangaroo Mother Care (iKMC)** dissemination campaign has reached more than 64 countries

Immunization

- Ensuring **quality service delivery of immunizations** alongside pediatric vaccinators in 17 countries
- Novel **vaccine hesitancy simulation curriculum** piloted for child immunization providers in 14 countries.

Early Childhood Development

- **Developmental surveillance and screening** in-service training and resource development in 6 countries
- Supporting **ECD integration** into clinical systems in 2 regions

Tobacco Control

- Promote strong policy environments through **advocacy workshops** in 6 regions attended by 17 countries

Mental Health

- **Community-based mental health grant program** reached mental health providers and stakeholders in 6 countries
- **Suicide screening** validation in 2 countries

Emergency Care

- **Pediatric first aid and emergency care** trainings (PEPP, PedFacts, & ETAT) implemented in 31 countries
