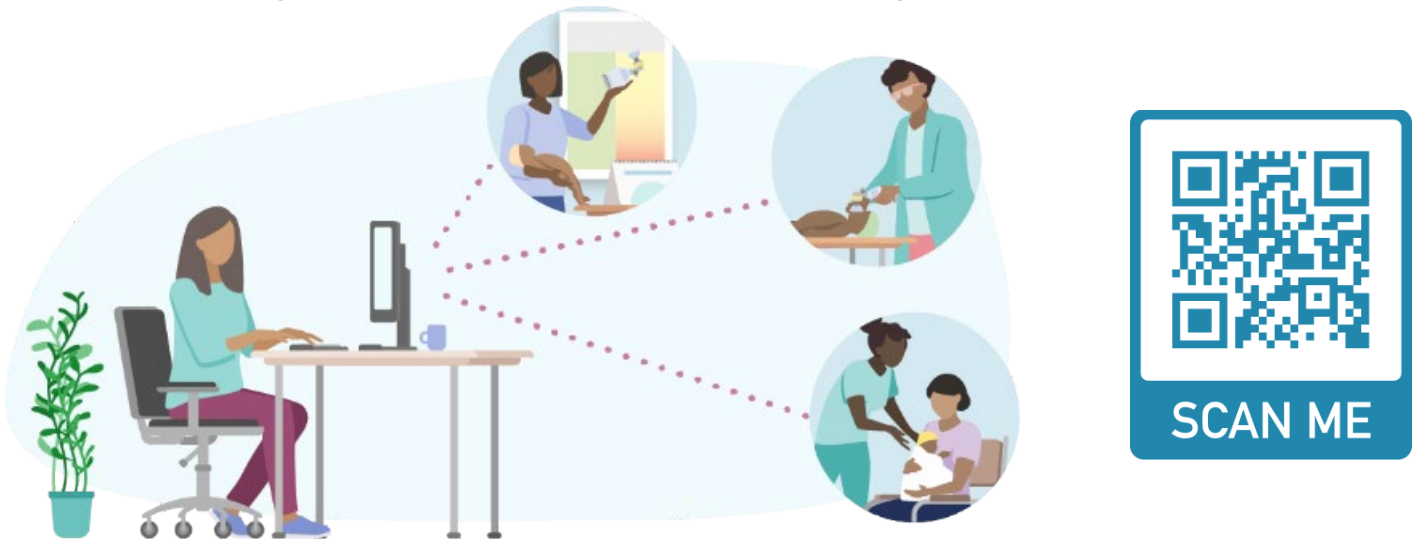

Training and Implementation support for Improving Essential Newborn Care (ENC)



Training alone is not enough

Education is important, but it is just one piece of the puzzle necessary to help babies survive and thrive. After more than a decade since the launch of Helping Babies Breathe (HBB) in 2010, it has become increasingly clear that a single training experience is not enough to achieve sustained reductions in newborn mortality.

For this reason, the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), in collaboration with technical experts and global partners, developed a support package that will help to ensure training in Essential Newborn Care (ENC) is supplemented with evidence-based strategies that accelerate the translation of education into practice.

Introducing CRISP – Customized mentorship and Implementation Support Package *A solution for translating training into sustained practice and improved outcomes*

CRISP is a comprehensive package that includes in-person or online ENCC training plus supplemental mentorship sessions and resources on topics to support implementation as well as retention of knowledge and skills.

CRISP Components

In addition to the ENC Now! open access online materials, the CRISP Package offers the following components:

- Customized training in ENC Now! and related platforms and tools
- Customized mentorship sessions
- Access to Digital Assessments
- Access to supplementary resources and tools to support program implementation and practice change



How CRISP works

Mentorship: Bridging the gap between training and clinical practice

Mentorship is a critical aspect of CRISP, as it provides a bridge between training and practice. Individuals and organizations that sign up for CRISP will complete an intake survey to assess specific needs. Groups of 6-8 participants will then be assigned to an experienced Global Mentor who will tailor their sessions to ensure groups get support best suited for their needs.

Mentorship sessions cover topics such as: health systems strengthening, quality improvement, monitoring and evaluation, program implementation, program management, facilitation skills and ongoing practice.

Flexible



Training and mentoring activities will take place remotely over the course of several months in the context of an ongoing, two-way relationship between the Global Mentor and the group.

Affordable



CRISP provides remote training and mentorship, which eliminates expenses, such as travel, accommodation, and venue costs, typically associated with organizing and attending in-person courses.

Sustainable



Global Mentors in collaboration with local experts will lead this program, working in high need settings to offer this digital training to suit different country contexts. The goal is for the local experts to become global mentors themselves, thereby building long-term capacity for local implementation.
