Getting Started with MHS PDMP

The Military Health System (MHS) Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) is an electronic database that collects prescription data on designated medications dispensed within the Military Health System in the United States, Puerto Rico, and Guam. MHS users are able to view controlled substances dispensed at military hospitals or clinics (MTFs) as well as claims processed with other health insurance and cash claims from the 46 states/entities that currently share data with MHS.



The data is available for access by authorized healthcare providers to assist in:

- Supporting access to the legitimate medical use of prescribed controlled medications for their patients
- Helping them identify, deter, or prevent drug misuse and diversion, and
- Facilitating and encouraging the identification of patients who may be addicted to prescribed medications, with the ability to offer intervention and treatment

How to Register

The DHA Pharmacy Operations Division (POD), in conjunction with the Pain Management Workgroup, is developing a DHA Procedure Instruction (DHA-PI) that will provide guidance on recommended use of the MHS PDMP with the requirement of registration. Until the DHA-PI is published, providers and pharmacists are encouraged to register and utilize the MHS PDMP to optimize their patient's care for the delivery of care. Registered pharmacists and providers can also have delegates registered to create and review patient reports.

To Register:

- Navigate to <u>mhs.pmpaware.net</u> and select 'create an account'
- Use your .mil email address to register and create a password
- Select your user role under the healthcare professional list
- Complete the required fields for your account
- Check your inbox for an email to verify your registration

Auto-Registration Feature
